**Standard 222 - Aircraft Marking and Registration****You will need to provide the following;**

- i) A complete Transport Canada Civil Aviation (TCCA) Form [26-0522](#)– Application for Registration.
- ii) Proof you are the aircraft owner (e.g. a statement of construction from plans or raw materials, kit bill of sale).
- iii) Proof that the aircraft is eligible for a flight authority pursuant to Part V of the Canadian Aviation Regulations (**Block 2 above**).
- iv) A clear photograph of the Aircraft Identification (ID) plate for the purpose of accurately identifying the make, model and serial number of the aircraft.
- v) Receipt for appropriate fee payment (online payment is available at <http://www.canada.ca/payments-air>).

Note: A 'next available' registration mark will be issued upon registration. Alternatively, you may reserve a mark or request a special (particular) mark for your amateur built aircraft by contacting your nearest Transport Canada Regional Office

*\*If any of the information changes after issuance of the C of R, the C of R will need to be re-issued. There is no charge for change of address.*
